

## THE SYMPOSIUM NOW CLOSES, LEAVING THE PARTICIPANTS FREE TO ORGANISE THEIR JOURNEYS HOME

For those unable to travel this Sunday afternoon/evening, and having to stay overnight to make their journeys on the Monday, there will be provided a guided stroll through Avilés, with outdoor activities, starting out at 17.30, and supper as usual at 21.00.

#### Monday 5 March

Any participants who have stayed overnight will set out on their journeys home this morning.

#### NOTES TO OIL THE WHEELS

- 1. The organisers will be at the Symposium location, the Residencia de Usos Múltiples, Edificio Fuero, Calle Fernando Morán 32, in Avilés, from 19.00 hours on Wednesday 28 March, to welcome participants arriving that evening.
- 2. We request that all participating groups advise us in advance of the approximate day and time of their expected arrival, so that we can organize their welcome, food and accommodation.
- 3. It would be very helpful if, in addition to their formal prepared presentations, each group of participants could bring with them some game or activity to share with other groups at the moments indicated in the programme: the late night party on the Saturday would be an ideal moment for these activities.
- 4. The Symposium officially finishes on Sunday 4 March at 14.00 hours, with the presentation of conclusions and manifesto at the closing ceremony. From that moment on, the various groups of participants will be making their journeys home. But as we did with the arrivals, we request that all groups advise us in advance of their expected time of departure.
- 5. We would remind all participant groups from Spain, that their presentations, whether written or audiovisual, must be in English (although they may if wished be in both English and Spanish, for easier comprehension)
- 6. The programme of activities is orientative, and may be subject to change: for example, in case of rain or other adverse weather some of the outdoor activities may have to be re-scheduled indoors.
